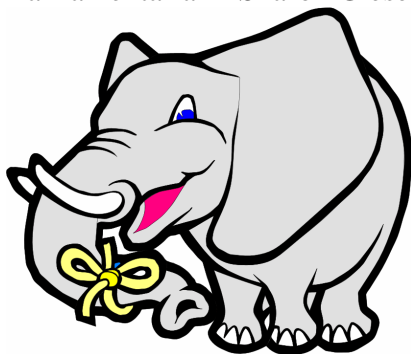

State

Jobs Bill

Our House and Senate just passed the AZ Jobs Bill. The bill will
cut corporate income taxes, expand some tax exemptions for
businesses, give income tax credits to businesses that create high-
wage jobs, and provide funds for business recruiting.

HB 2718

House Speaker Kirk Adams is sponsoring a bill to help fund
Sheriff Paul Babeu's task force to hunt down drug cartels and
human smugglers.

SB 1611

Senate President Russell Pearce is sponsoring a bill that would
require proof of legal status in order to purchase, register, or
operate a vehicle; enroll in public or private K-12 school, or attend
an AZ community college or university; obtain public housing; and
get any type of license in AZ.
